*Great news!* Pi Lambda Phi is on the verge of returning to Temple as a full-fledged student organization, recognized by the university. Planning is underway and resources have been allocated to reestablish PA Alpha Delta on campus with a founding father class in spring 2010.

### **Pi Lambda Phi Returns to Temple in 2010.**

The plan to reestablish the chapter began two years ago through a series of negotiations with Temple University and resulted in an agreement to allow Pi Lam to actively recruit new members beginning this fall.

To make the most of this opportunity, the IHQ has assigned its Director of Expansion, Ian Howe, to work exclusively with our chapter through the spring of 2010. He will live on campus, promote Pi Lam, arrange events and recruit new members. Ian recently oversaw the reorganization of the UVA chapter that resulted in more than 25 new members.

Ian has already made contact with campus organizations such as the Interfraternity Council. The IFC President was supportive saying, "Pi Lambda Phi has contributed to so much at Temple and has created many leaders. I look forward to meeting and working with you this coming year and am stoked for Pi Lambda Phi to come back."

What you receive as a dues-paying member:


- Voting privileges on alumni association matters and the right to hold office/serve on committees.
