Mentzer Fund for the Future

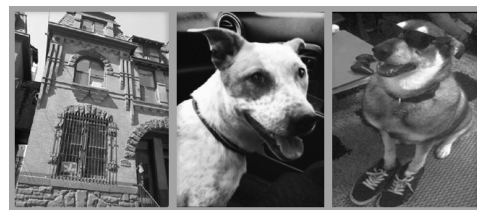
After raising nearly \$5,000 since 2011, we continue to dedicate ourselves to this fundraising effort for the family of Brother Bob Mentzer '92.

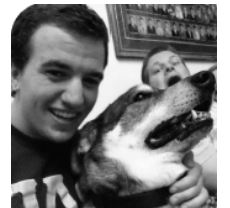
